


How to add your school email to iPhone mail app.

Click on the settings button



Click on Passwords and Account



Click on add account




Click on Microsoft Exchange

Microsoft Exchange

Enter in your school email. This is your username with @wdbqschools.org email domain. Your username should be the first 3 letters of your last name and first 3 letters of your first name. For example John Doe would be doejoh@wdbqschools.org. You can set the Description to School. Click Next


